189th Annual Convention & Leadership Training Conference



AUSTIN, TX - AUGUST 5-7, 2021

The 189th Annual Convention & Leadership Conference of the Alpha Delta Phi Fraternity will be held in Austin, TX from Thursday, August 5 through Saturday, August 7, 2021. Attendees and delegates should make arrangements to arrive Thursday morning. Sessions begin at 4:00pm on Thursday.

WHAT IS CONVENTION?

Pursuant to Article VII of the Constitution, Supreme Legislative Power of the Fraternity is vested in the Convention, and the Convention has original jurisdiction over constitutional questions and appellate jurisdiction over decisions of the Board of Governors and chapters.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Each chapter shall designate one delegate and one alternate delegate who shall be student brothers of the accrediting chapter. Each recognized alumni organization shall also designate one alumnus delegate and one alternate delegate who shall be alumni brothers but who need not have been student brothers of the accrediting organization's chapter. Only delegates, or in their absence the alternate delegate, present in person, may vote.

Chapter Presidents, Treasurers, Recruitment Chairs and Alumni Presidents are urged to attend as the delegates of their respective bodies. The Credentials Committee shall have authority to accredit all delegate credentials and set all expense payments.

Payment of all sums due the Fraternity (initiation, membership and/or organization fees) by each chapter and alumni organization in advance of the convention is essential to ensure the delegates are duly accredited.

WHEN SHOULD I REGISTER?

Undergraduate delegates are urged to register before the end of their school year and to provide their e-mail address and telephone number where they can be reached over the summer before the convention. Alumni may register anytime before the event. Hotel booking deadline is, July 15, 2021.

REGISTRATION FEE

Alumnus \$300 USD (\$250 until 5/10) Undergraduate \$200 USD (\$150 until 5/10)

Payment may be made in either U.S. or Canadian currency. The registration fee includes all convention materials, sessions, and programming; welcome reception on Thursday evening, breakfast and lunch on Friday and Saturday; and, Saturday evening banquet. Additional tickets for guests will be available for all activities.

HOW DO I BOOK MY TRAVEL?

One undergraduate delegate from each chapter should arrange their own travel using the chapter (or alumni association) funds. Each chapter will be reimbursed in accordance with the policies of Alpha Delta Phi following the convention.

Travel expenses are reimbursed only for undergraduate delegates for actual out of pocket expenses (airline, train or bus fare; gas and tolls) and provided (1) the delegate has registered by JULY 15, 2021 (2) fares are purchased at least 30 days prior to travel (to obtain lowest fare possible) and (3) delegates attend all Convention sessions (keynote sessions, business sessions and leadership workshop programs). Undergraduate delegates are urged to travel by car and carpool if at all possible.
